A fundamental concern of social science is to conceptualize phenomena appropriately so that they can be studied theoretically and empirically following codified procedures. Christian Gudehus discusses the associated problems and requirements in view of the network character of events that are commonly referred to as violence, suffering, coercion or harm, for example.

Christian Gudehus is a social scientist with a penchant for social and cultural psychology. Together with Pradeep Chakkarath, he founded the *Journal of HARM* which has been published as an open access publication since January 2022. At the same time, the first issue of *Trauma Kultur Gesellschaft* was published by Psychosozial-Verlag; he co-edits the German-language journal together with colleagues from the clinical field, the social sciences and humanities. As a lecturer and

researcher at Ruhr University Bochum, he focuses on the topics of collective violence, its conditions, manifestations and consequences.
